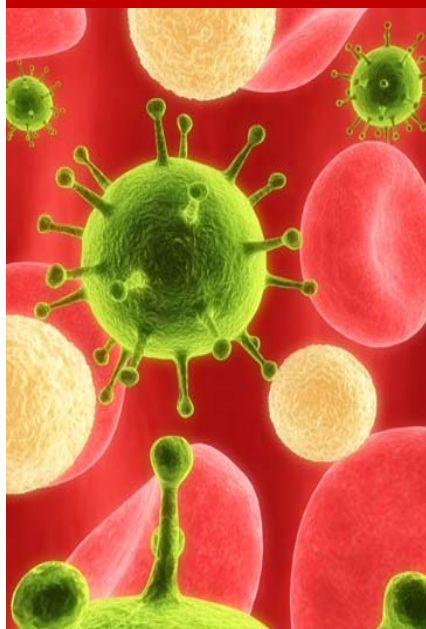




# Infection Control Course Series
