Format of the program

1. A 9-month program. (April to December 2016)

 - a. HKPIC - Case Meeting biweekly (Thursday 10:30 -13:00), Monthly Meeting (2nd Wednesday 17:00 – 19:00)
 - b. Pre-approved training activities from accredited toxicology training units; pre-approved activities should not exceed 1/2 of the minimal hours (i.e 6 hours)

Case Meeting at HKPIC, Room 2A, Block K, United Christian Hospital
Monthly Meeting at K Lecture Theatre, Block K, United Christian Hospital
5. Fee: \$3,000
6. Participants
 - a. Doctors of relevant specialty with the recommendation from COS
 - b. Total participants – 20
7. It is a 80 hours programme & certificate would be issued upon satisfactory completion of the following
 - a. At least 75% attendance of the monthly session (≥ 7 training sessions)
 - b. Submit 2 presentations of interesting poisoning cases from his/ her own unit
 - c. Attend at least 12 hours of accredited training activities
 - d. Completed the MCQ assessment at the end of the program
