Format of the program

1. A 9-month program. (April to December 2011)
2. 3 hour session monthly on the 3rd Wednesday in each month from 09:30 to 12:30.
3. Each session consist of 2 lectures and case presentations by participants.
4. Participants are required to attend minimal 12 hours of accredited training activities
 - a. HKPIC - Case Meeting every Thursday 10:30 -13:00, Monthly Meeting every 3rd Wednesday 16:30 – 18:30
 - b. Pre-approved training activities from accredited toxicology training units
5. Venue: Lecture & Case presentation sessions at F1 Conference Room, Block F, United Christian Hospital/
Case Meeting at HKPIC, Room 2A, Block K, United Christian Hospital/
Monthly Meeting at Lecture Theatre, G/F, Block F, United Christian Hospital.
6. Fee: \$2,000
7. Participants
 - a. Higher trainees or fellow of relevant specialty with the recommendation from COS
 - b. Total participants – 20 (about one doctor/ clinical unit)
8. It is a 80 hours programme & certificate would be issued upon satisfactory completion of the following
 - a. At least 75% attendance of the monthly session (≥ 7 training sessions)
 - b. Submit 2 presentations of interesting poisoning cases from his/ her own unit
 - c. Attend at least 12 hours of accredited training activities
 - d. Completed the MCQ assessment at the end of the program
